Dear Mr Scanagatti,



Legionowo has over 50 thousand citizens. It is a relatively young city in the centre of Poland, ca 20 km from the capital Warsaw. Once a suburban resort, Legionowo now is an independent city. Through the strategy of development Legionowo offers its residents a high standard of living: a well-developed base of educational and health care, a wide range of cultural and sports institutions as well as convenient public transport. The largest investments are: the Town Hall in the centre of Legionowo with a concert hall and public service area, sports hall Arena Legionowo and railway station co-financed with external funds including EU share.

Our partnership would mean the mutual support in various fields of activity, including youth educational and sports exchange, cooperation in social assistance activities, experiences and between sports clubs.
